So what exactly is polyethylene film?

You see polyethylene film everyday, including produce and bread bags, product wrap, shipping envelopes, resealable food bags, shopping bags and more.

- It is a performance plastic with endless uses to make our lives better, from protecting our food from spoilage to helping us safely ship products.
- Most often film is made from low-density polyethylene. If it stretches when pulled in your hands, it is likely Recycle Code 4 polyethylene.
